Make Work Papers Sparkle. Then the audit program should be updated to include the step—or maybe the work paper isn’t needed at all. 3. The preparer should sign off on each work paper (so it’s clear who created it). 4. Audit program steps should be signed off as the work is performed (not at the end of the audit—just before review).

Workpapers summarize your audit actions, such as planning the audit. Schedules show what steps you take to reach a conclusion. For example, to support your conclusion that cash is correctly stated on the balance sheet, you may prepare a schedule showing all bank reconciliations affirming that they
