However, the World Gastroenterology Organisation (WGO) stated that one in 17 people will develop some form of dysphagia in their lifetime 27 citing a 2011 study in the UK that reported a prevalence rate of 11% for dysphagia in the general community 54. The WGO also estimated that dysphagia affects 40-70% of patients with ...
