A hierarchy of ego mechanisms was devised that ordered defenses along a continuum that reflected the following two dimensions: (1) immaturity-maturity and (2) psychopathology-mental health.

Thus the ego in its relations with the id and with the outside world — relations which may be the source of unpleasure or of feelings of fear — is analyzed in the light of its avoidance mechanisms (the various forms of negation), in the light of its aggressive or altruistic strategies.

In the first definitive book on defense mechanisms, *The Ego and the Mechanisms of Defense* (1936), Anna Freud introduced the concept of signal anxiety; she stated that it was "not directly a conflicted instinctual tension but a signal occurring in the ego of an anticipated instinctual tension".
