After the WMA adopted the Declaration of Helsinki in 1964, the WHO directed CIOMS to translate the declaration into a document that could be used to guide member countries—especially Third World countries. The CIOMS manual, Proposed International Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical Research Involving Human Subjects, was released in 1982.

In addition, the 2002 International Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical Research Involving Human Subjects were merged with the CIOMS 2009 International Ethical Guidelines for Epidemiological Studies, which included topics such as biobanking and research with health-related data.
