Forty patients (18.1%) had an unstable injury on CT with 100% MRI concordance. CONCLUSION. In pediatric trauma patients suspected of having a CSI, a normal cervical spine CT is sufficient to rule out a clinically significant CSI as no child with a normal cervical CT was found to be radiographically or clinically unstable.
