These "targeted sanctions" were designed to be tightly-focused so as to limit their humanitarian impact. Indeed, all UN sanctions today are "targeted," and are in general grouped into three categories: sanctions targeted at individuals, those targeted at specific commodities, and those targeted at particular regions in a country. A major controversy has arisen over sanctions that directly name individuals.

By further exacerbating conflict and chaos, targeted sanctions regimes can negatively impact the credibility of the UN and its ability to facilitate a cooperative global realm of governance. The inability for sanctions to impair the capacity of targeted governments is the result of actions taken by regimes to divert the impact of economic restrictions away from the elite.
