The detonation of the atomic bomb and the end of World War II led to disagreements among the "Big Three" wartime Allies and a shift in American attitudes toward the Soviet Union.

At the end of World War II, English writer George Orwell used cold war, as a general term, in his essay "You and the Atomic Bomb", published 19 October 1945 in the British newspaper Tribune. Contemplating a world living in the shadow of the threat of nuclear warfare , Orwell looked at James Burnham 's predictions of a polarized world, writing:

Chapter 36: The Cold War Begins, 1945-1952. An economic extension of the New Deal proposed by Harry Truman that called for higher minimum wage, housing and full employment. It led only to the Housing Act of 1949 and the Social Security Act of 1950 due to opposition in congress.

The Cold War, the struggle to contain Soviet communism, was not a war, but it was also not a peace. In 1947 , Congress passed the National Security Act , creating the Department of Defense . The department was headed by a new cabinet officer, the secretary of defense .

Meeting in April 1945, just days after Franklin D. Roosevelt's death and Truman's succession to the presidency, delegates drafted the organization's founding charter, which closely resembled the charter of the failed League of Nations after World War I. Because World War II had proved that the United States could no longer remain isolated from world affairs, the new charter passed easily through the Senate ratification process that summer.
