The Modular Architecture of Grammar presents a state-of-the-art introduction to automodular grammar, a theory based on Fodor's (1983) modularity of mind hypothesis. According to the Modularity of Grammar Hypothesis, autonomous modules generate linguistic representations (e.g., sentence structures, propositions), but do not interact (p. 7). The representations that these systems generate, however, are connected via mapping principles governed by the interface (meta-) module.
