Atonality in its broadest sense is music that lacks a tonal center, or key. Atonality, in this sense, usually describes compositions written from about 1908 to the present day, where a hierarchy of pitches focusing on a single, central tone is not used, and the notes of the chromatic scale function independently of one another (Kennedy 1994).

Forte is well known for his book *The Structure of Atonal Music* (1973), which traces many of its roots to an article of a decade earlier: "A Theory of Set-Complexes for Music" (1964).
